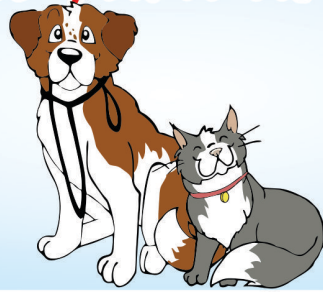


# A Huge Thank You to our Supporters!

The Ozark Dale County Humane Society was incorporated as a no-kill shelter in October of 2004 and granted a not-for-profit status by the IRS as a 501(c)3 organization in August 2005.

This no-kill facility is small, with 14 dog kennels and a small cattery, but the ODCHS has been able to save hundreds of animals through the years. They supply current vaccinations, disease testing, and any needed medical treatment to the animals they rescue (including spaying and neutering) as well as provide food, shelter, exercise, love and attention!

The ODCHS is extremely grateful to the compassionate, generous supporters and to the many wonderful dedicated volunteers. It is because of them, that the organization will continue to help more homeless animals in 2016 and years to come.

When people ask what the ODCHS needs most, the reply is usually, "help." There are many kinds of help that the animals need: volunteers, financial donations, pet food, and cleaning supplies are just a few of those needs. In many cases, animals rescued by ODCHS have not been fortunate enough to experience the lasting kindness of humans and are so grateful to have a warm place to sleep, regular food, exercise and attention.

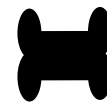
